# YOUR DOLLARS AT WORK

This year has been a busy one for the Foundation, preparing for our multi-year, Transforming Stevenson Campaign, as well as continuing to prepare for our redevelopment campaign as we await final government approval.

The support of our community this year, including individual donors, service clubs, businesses, foundations, and the Stevenson Memorial Hospital Auxiliary, has been amazing! Thanks to you, we were able to disburse over \$950,369.32 to Stevenson Memorial Hospital in the 2016-2017 year in support of several pieces of priority hospital equipment that have made such a difference for Stevenson's patients.

Your generosity this year has allowed for some amazing improvements in Stevenson's Medical/Surgical Unit. Your support of our Refurbish a Room Campaign has made it possible to completely refurbish five patient spaces this year, with new beds featuring technology that is helping to reduce patient falls and prevent bed sores, and new bedside and over-bed tables that are more easily sanitized.

The purchase of a bladder scanner for this Unit is also helping to reduce the number of necessary catheterizations.

Additionally, thanks to the generosity of a private foundation, the purchase of a Macerator is reducing the presence and spread of bacteria in patient spaces, reducing the risk of outbreaks like C. Difficile in this Unit.

Your support this year has helped us to improve care in Stevenson's Emergency Department through the purchase

of a new ECG Machine and other critical equipment like stretchers, IV pumps and vital signs monitors, allowing the hospital to replace its older equipment, which was worn out and past its recommended lifespan. Now, Stevenson's medical professionals have several pieces of new and innovative equipment readily available, so that they can provide faster, higher quality care to the nearly 40,000 patients annually that rely on this vital hospital service.

The Obstetrics ward is benefiting tremendously from the purchase of an Acudose Medication Dispenser this year, generously funded by a private foundation. This equipment is making drug administration much safer, ensuring that the right patient receives the right medication at the right time, as well as ensuring greater security in drug storage, and improved efficiency for staff.

Your generosity this year has made it possible for the hospital to make several other critical equipment purchases benefitting many of the hospital's departments, supporting faster, safer, and higher quality care. The purchase of a new ultrasound machine for the Diagnostic Imaging Unit is supporting higher quality and more efficient ultrasound exams, and a new autoclave for the Surgical Unit is supporting more efficient and effective sterilization of operating tools and equipment. Additionally, many other pieces of essential every-day equipment have been purchased, replacing older equipment that was well past its lifespan.

The Foundation has also continued to support the Hospital's redevelopment project this year, which is currently entering stage two, through the provision of


critical planning funds.

# FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS



**TOTAL DISBURSEMENTS: \$950,369.32**


## REVENUE
