- ✓ Increased number of patient rooms in the Inpatient Care Unit
- ✓ Our Surgical Services Department will more than double in size
- ✓ An enhanced Birthing Unit with new labour and delivery rooms, reception and family/waiting area
- ✔ Renovations will also be made to many other service areas of the hospital



EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

Our Emergency Department accounts for over half of all hospital visits. Built in 1964, it was meant to accommodate only 7,000 annual visits. Now, we are seeing close to 40,000 visits per year. The new, much larger Emergency Department will feature an expanded waiting area and an increase number of patient rooms.
